The Blood, The Book, and The Blessed Hope

*The entirety of Your Word is truth, and every one of Your righteous judgments endures forever.
—Psalm 119:160.*

As I listened to some people talk this week about how they did not know what was true, I was reminded of the words of my childhood Pastor, "I believe in **the Blood, the Book, and the Blessed Hope.**" I am so thankful that I have found the words of assurance in the Scriptures: assurance that Christ died for my sins, that He shed His blood to pay my sin-debt on Calvary.
